Epistle Reading

Hebrews 9:11-14

Brethren: when Christ appeared as the high priest of the good things to come, He entered once for all through the greater and more perfect tabernacle, not made by hands (that is, not of this creation), nor again by virtue of blood of goats and calves, but by virtue of His own blood into the Holy Place, thus securing eternal redemption. For if the blood of goats and bulls and the sprinkled ashes of a heifer sanctify the unclean unto the purification of the flesh, how much more will the blood of Christ, who through the eternal Spirit offered Himself unblemished to God, cleanse your conscience from dead works to serve the living God?

Gospel Reading

Mark 10:32-45

At that time, taking the twelve, Jesus began to tell them what was to happen to him, saying, 'Behold, we go up to Jerusalem, and the Son of man shall be delivered unto the chief priests, and unto the scribes: and they shall condemn him to death, and shall deliver him to the Gentiles. And they shall mock him, and shall scourge him, and shall spit upon him, and shall kill him, and the third day he shall rise again.'

And James and John, the sons of Zebedee, come unto him, saying, 'Master, we would that thou shouldst do for us whatsoever we shall desire'. And he said unto them, 'What would ye that I should do for you?' They said unto him, 'Grant unto us that we may sit, one on thy right hand, and the other on thy left hand, in thy glory'. But Jesus said unto them, 'Ye know not what ye ask: can ye drink of the cup that I drink of? and be baptized with the baptism that I am baptized with?' And they said unto him, 'We can'. And Jesus said unto them, 'Ye shall indeed drink of the cup that I drink of: and with the baptism that I am baptized withal shall ye be baptized: but to sit on my right hand and on my left hand is not mine to give, but it shall be given to them for whom it is prepared'.

And when the ten heard it, they began to be much displeased with James and John. But Jesus called them to him, and saith unto them, 'Ye know that they which are accounted to rule over the Gentiles exercise lordship over them: and their great ones exercise authority upon them. But so shall it not be among you: but whosoever will be great among you, shall be your minister: and whosoever of you will be the chiefest, shall be servant of all. For even the Son of man came not to be ministered unto, but to minister, and to give his life a ransom for many.'
